PARENT COMMITMENT AND STATEMENT OF COOPERATION

Home Education

Cross Creek Christian School is a parent-directed home education program and parents are required to teach their children at home with assignments according to lesson plans provided by the teachers. Two days a week of teaching does not complete a student's education and parents are responsible to teach on the days that the student is not attending classes.

Families are encouraged to enhance and individualize the home education program as needed. Cross Creek Christian School's administration and teachers are available to give guidance in regards to individualizing a child's education. Parents are first and foremost responsible for their child's education. The partnership between the parent and the teacher will be based on trust and a mutual desire to honor the Lord Jesus Christ in all that is taught to our children. The Parent, as the primary instructor, is responsible for keeping and reporting attendance and grade reports.

Reporting

I understand that I must complete all required attendance and progress reports. Failure to turn in these reports will lead to your child's dismissal from Cross Creek.

Parent Partnership

I understand that Cross Creek is a cooperative venture among all of the families that they serve. I understand the importance of volunteering and participating in the various activities and fundraising efforts of the school. I will volunteer as a classroom parent at least one day per semester.

Employment
