



## Graduation Requirements

### Graduation Requirements

A graduate of Cross Creek must satisfy the following requirements:

- 22.5 total High School Credits
- A minimum score of 860 on the SAT (Math and Verbal), or a minimum score of 16 on the ACT; or 12<sup>th</sup> grade equivalency on the Classical Learning Test (CLT) or TABE Assessment; or successful completion of the HiSet.
- Students with an Individual Educational Learning Plan (IEP) due to a documented learning disability may request a reduced or exemption from the minimum score requirement. This is a case by case basis pending the IEP.
